### "Back to the Basics"

When we stop doing what we've always done out of habit and take the time to re-examine our beliefs, questions arise and the excitement we felt when we first realized that that impulsion to seek and the desire to feel atone-ment <u>is</u> Spirit nudging and guiding us to awaken to the One ... the One that is Life Itself! The yearning to re-kindle the passion surges and we feel alive <u>as</u> Spirit inseparably connected with all of Creation.

You may feel the pull of Spirit competing with the pushback of fear, the inclination to hide in the familiar. Chris Trout asks, "Can you let go of what you have insisted is true and, instead, choose the Truth that will set you free?"

To live fully as Spirit is the ultimate freedom and it is accessible to all of us to the degree that we are willing and receptive. Ernest Holmes taught us that we can only attract that

which we become mentally and until you feel yourself as your potential you won't have the capacity to have the experience. The Truth that sets us free resides in the knowingness that Spirit as us has the capacity and that It is what is calling us to unite our inner world and our outer experiences. It is what calls us with a sublime sense "I already knew that yet I didn't know I did." It's when we catch that we are greater than we ever realized and that it's only the beginning. We have access to greatness that is Spirit in us as us and Spirit is illimitable!

So where do we start such a journey? We begin by "unpacking" our assumptions in the light of day to sort out: What do I believe? What have I adopted from some external source? Do I believe it? Does it make spiritual sense? Can I rely on it? Dr. Holmes wrote in the Science of ... CONTINUED ... 14

### Practitioners' Corner

### ... Maxine Clair, RScP

If you have already established a deliberate meditative practice, this might be a good time to re-commit to meditating daily. In addition to your sitting practice, you may want to consider a moving meditation or chanting. No matter what your practice, you may want to focus on being more open to the present—now—moment.

If you are new to meditation, for now consider simply noticing "now" moments which can serve as preview to the main attraction. Rather than dwelling in yesterday or tomorrow, in any moment, you can be aware of the present—the only moment that you are actually in—by realizing where you are and what you are doing, and eventually, what you are thinking. You're walking down the street and feel a breeze across your cheek. Say silently *now the wind is brushing my cheek*. Loading the dishwasher, examining a melon at the market, brushing your teeth, stepping off a curb, just say to yourself, *now I am squeezing the cantaloupe*, etc. Instantaneously, for a fleeting microsecond, you come into awareness of the moment you're in.

Now I am stepping onto the escalator. Now I am turning the steering wheel. Now I am breathing in. After some practice, you will find that you need not finish the sentence in order to experience a little shift in awareness. Saying the word "now" will do.

### What is a Practitioner?

A practitioner is one who endeavors to heal themselves and others through the recognition of the creative power of Mind and the ever availability of Good. Practitioners are individuals who have been trained in the art, skill and science of Affirmative Prayer. A Practitioner seeks to demonstrate the power of spiritual realization in everyday affairs and believes in Divine guidance. A Practitioner sees through whatever condition someone is facing to the spiritual truth of being, bringing about a change in the circumstance. Practitioners are bound by a high code of ethics and licensed to practice professionally.



Challenged to lean into the possibility of thoroughly experiencing aliveness, of living "oneness," we may falter and experience fear. We can allow emotions to paralyze us or we can be grateful that they are there to signal that it is time to pray and push through to an ever expanding experience of Life.

Ours is a simple faith: One Divine Source expressing Itself as all of Creation, always allowing access to Itself, ever encouraging Its expression to fully embody the Truth of its being, always calling creation to be its most magnificent. Many in seeking to explain our philosophy have made it seem complex. It is neither complicated nor convoluted. Often, people cannot believe that it is so simple.
